As you know, the breakfast program with Brian Foley and Yellow Candle packaging scheduled for this Sunday has been canceled. We hope to have Brian Foley speak at a future program later this year.

We still plan to mail yellow candles to all Temple members residing in CT, and out of state members upon request. WE URGENTLY NEED HELP ASSEMBLING THE YELLOW CANDLE PACKAGES, but, consistent with the Temple's Coronavirus precautions regarding group projects, we are asking individuals or families to volunteer to help us by assembling packages in the safety of their own homes.

We need to assemble nearly 800 boxes, and have them ready to mail early next week. We are separating the candles and packing material by zip code into groups of approximately 50 candles. Each 50 candle package will include explicit instructions explaining how to assemble your boxes and what needs to be placed in each box. Volunteers will be able to pick up one or more packages of 50 candles either this Friday or Sunday (March 20th or 22nd) from either:
